ALL BOATS MUST CHECK IN ON VHF CHANNEL 69 WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE DURING THE CHECK IN PERIOD 08:00 TO 09:30.

SCHEDULE OF RACE:

FLEETS START IN THE ORDER LISTED ON ATTACHMENT I

STARTING LINE: Between Mark "A" and an orange marker on the St Francis Yacht Club race deck. Cross the line from East to West.

COURSE: From the start, to Duxbury Reef (YRA DUX) Whistle Buoy "1DR" to starboard, then to the finish.

FINISH: Between the abandoned USCG Pier on the northwest shore of Drakes Bay and a Committee Boat at anchor. Leave the Committee Boat to starboard. Boats finishing after 1900 hours on Saturday take their own time if no response from RC, and report it to the Committee Boat at 0900 hours on Sunday on Channel 72. In heavy fog, upon request, the RC will give the latitude and longitude location of the Finish Line.

CALCULATED DISTANCE: 27.5 Nautical miles.

TIME LIMIT: All boats not finishing in Drakes Bay by 2359 hours on Saturday June 6, 2009 will be scored DNF. Boats finishing after 1900 hours on June 6, 2009 if not receiving a response from the RC, must take their own time and report it to the YRA Answering Service (415) 771-9500. RC will attempt to maintain a watch on the radio for approaching boats & for safety. If heavy fog obscures the finish area, upon request, the RC will give their latitude and longitude location.

MISSING MARK: In the event a mark is missing the course shall be the same as indicated in these instructions. Boats shall round the mark by navigation to the Lat/Lon of the mark as indicated in the most recent Light List. Skipper shall maintain a log of the Lat/Lon and time of rounding.

WITHDRAWAL/DNF: All Boats withdrawing or not finishing within the time limit must report the fact to the YRA answering service (415) 771-9500 immediately upon locating a telephone.

PROTEST: In accordance with the YRA Standing Sailing Instructions. Address for the YRA office is YRA, Quarters 35S Fort Mason, San Francisco, 94123.

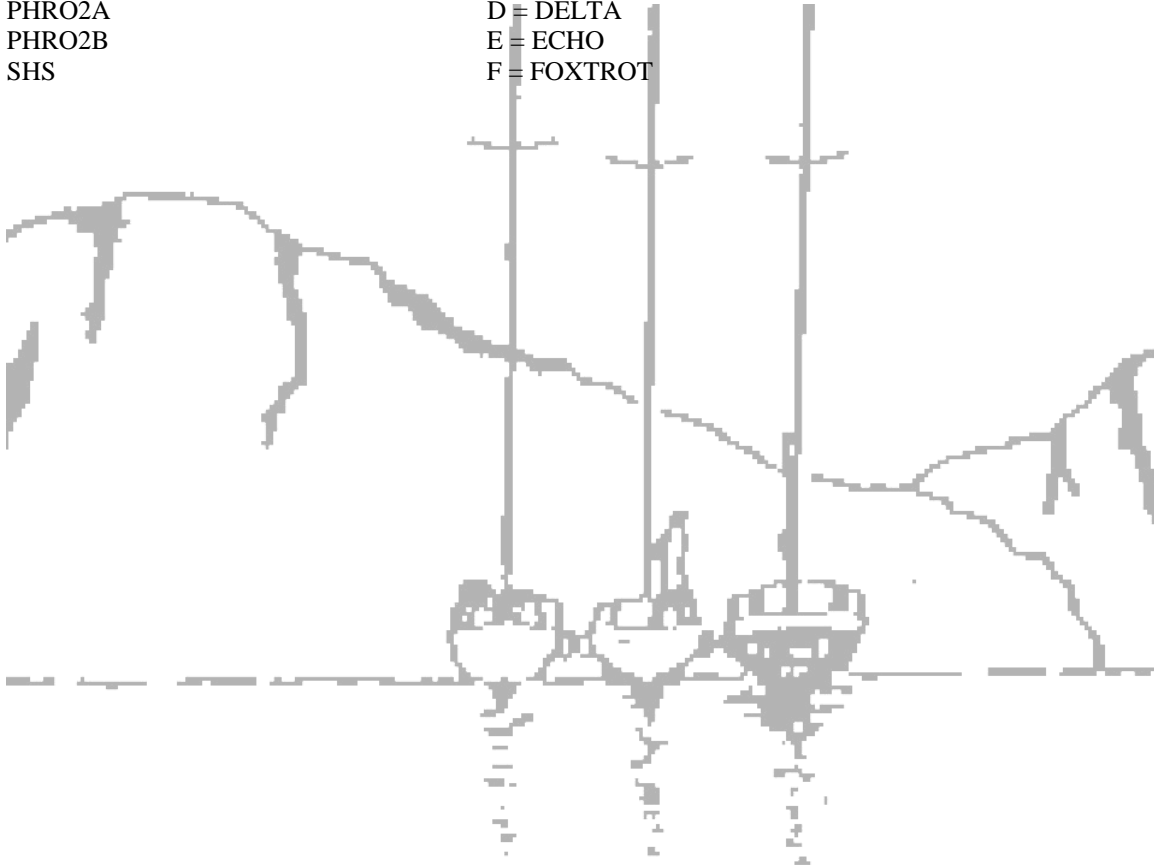

FLEETS START IN THE ORDER LISTED ON ATTACHMENT I

STARTING LINE: Between a race committee buoy approximately 1,500 yards northeast of the abandoned USCG Pier and a Committee Boat, leaving the line to seaward.

COURSE 1: From the start, to Duxbury Reef (YRA DUX) Whistle Buoy “1DR” to port, then to finish.

COURSE 2: From the start, to the Approach Buoy R “SF” (YRA SF) to port, then to finish.

COURSE 3: From the start, to the Southeast Farallone Island to port, then to finish.

FINISH: Boats shall finish between Corinthian Yacht Club Deck (A large white building Lat./Lon. approximately 37 52.283’ x 122 27.33’) and an orange temporary set approximately 100 yards off the deck. Cross the line from West to East. See Time Limit.

RESTRICTED: The water between Raccoon Strait Buoy “3” G Fl G 4s and Belvedere.

CALCULATED DISTANCE: **Course 1:** 29.9 Nautical miles. **Course 2:** 34.5 Nautical miles. **Course 3:** 48.4 Nautical miles.

TIME LIMIT: All boats not finishing by 2359 hours on Sunday June 7, 2009 will be scored DNF. . Boats finishing after 1900 hours on Sunday June 7, 2009 if not receiving a response from the RC, must take their own time and report it to the YRA Answering Service (415) 771-9500. RC will attempt to maintain a watch on the radio for approaching boats & for safety.

MISSING MARK: In the event a mark is missing the course shall be the same as indicated in these instructions. Boats shall round the mark by navigation to the Lat/Lon of the mark as indicated in the most recent Light List. Skipper shall maintain a log of the Lat/Lon and time of rounding.
