## DRAKES BAY RACE

Sponsored by the Corinthian Yacht Club

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. This race will be governed by the rules as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 – 2012* and the *YRA Standing Sailing Instructions*, except as any of these are changed by these sailing instructions.
- 1.2. RRS 40 is deleted and replaced with “all competitors shall wear life jackets or adequate personal buoyancy while on deck”.

### 2. ENTRIES

- 2.1. This race is open to all qualified yacht owners who are season racers in OYRA, or have paid a one-time entry fee for this YRA event, and have met the minimum equipment requirements for YRA Ocean Races.
- 2.2. Yachts that do not have a completed Minimum Equipment List on file with the YRA and/or have not submitted a Crew/Boat information sheet for the race will not be considered starters and will be scored DNS.

### 3. COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1. **ALL YACHTS MUST CHECK IN ON VHF CHANNEL 69 WITH THE RACE COMMITTEE DURING THE CHECK IN PERIOD 0830 TO 0930 ON BOTH SATURDAY AND SUNDAY.**
- 3.2. Failure of a boat to check in before the deadline and establish two-way communication with the race committee will result in the boat not being considered to have started and will be scored DNS. The Race Committee may make announcements on, and will monitor **Channel 69**, but will not be able to respond to queries in the one minute before and after a start. Vessels in need of *safety assistance* should hail the Coast Guard on Channel 16 in case of emergency.

### 5. START

- 5.1. **SATURDAY** – Between an orange panel on the CYC Race Deck and a temporary mark set approximately 100 yds off the deck. Cross the line from East to West.
- 5.2. **SUNDAY** – Between a race committee buoy approximately 1,500 yards northeast of the abandoned USCG Pier and a Committee Boat, leaving the line to seaward.

### 6. COURSE

- 6.1. **SATURDAY COURSE:** From the start, to Duxbury Reef (YRA DUX) Whistle Buoy “1DR” to starboard, then to the finish. Approximately 31 nm.

- 6.2. SUNDAY COURSE 1:** From the start, to Duxbury Reef (YRA DUX) Whistle Buoy "1DR" to port, then to finish. Approximately 31 nm
  - 6.3. SUNDAY COURSE 2:** From the start, to the Approach Buoy R "SF" (YRA SF) to port, then to finish. Approximately 35.5
  - 6.4. SUNDAY COURSE 3:** From the start, to the Southeast Farallon Island to port, then to finish. Approximately 49.4 nm
- 7. FINISH**
- 7.1. SATURDAY** – Boats shall finish between the abandoned USCG Pier on the northwest shore of Drakes Bay and a Committee Boat at anchor. Leave the Committee Boat to starboard. In heavy fog, upon request, the RC will give the latitude and longitude location of the Finish Line.
  - 7.2. SUNDAY** – Boats shall finish between the Corinthian Yacht Club Race Deck (A large white building Lat./Lon. approximately 37° 52.283' x 122° 27.33') and an orange temporary set approximately 100 yards off the deck. Cross the line from West to East.
- 8. TIME LIMIT**
- 8.1.** All boats not finishing by 2359 hours on either Saturday June 5, 2010 or Sunday June 6, 2010 will be scored DNF.
  - 8.2.** Boats finishing after 2000 hours on Saturday June 5, 2010 if not receiving a response from the RC must take their own time and report it to the YRA Answering Service at (415) 771-9500 and to the Committee Boat at 0900 hours on Sunday on Channel 69. RC will attempt to maintain a watch on the radio for approaching boats & for safety.
  - 8.3.** Yachts finishing after 2000 hours on Sunday June 6, 2010 if not receiving a response from the RC must take their own time and report it to the YRA Answering Service at (415) 771-9500. RC will attempt to maintain a watch on the radio for approaching boats & for safety.
- 9. RESTRICTED AREAS**
- 9.1.** The water between Raccoon Strait Buoy "3" G FI G 4s and Belvedere
- 10. MISSING MARK**
- 10.1.** In the event a mark is missing the course shall be the same as indicated in these instructions. Boats shall round the mark by navigation to the Lat/Lon of the mark as indicated in the most recent Light List. Skipper shall maintain a log of the Lat/Lon and time of rounding.
- 11. REPORTING FINISH/WITHDRAWAL/DNF**
- 11.1.** Boats finishing during the night will illuminate the boat's sail numbers to assist the RC. In addition, each boat should record her own finish time and note both the boat ahead and behind, whenever possible.
  - 11.2.** Boats not finishing within the time limit or boats not completing the course, unless directly and specifically acknowledged by the RC, must report the fact to the YRA answering service at 415-771-9500. A yacht may alternatively withdraw using the automated Pinpoint Yacht Tracking telephone system by calling 800-451-2302, selecting the "withdrawal" option, and providing all requested data, including a five-digit sail number. If a yacht's sail number has fewer than five digits, one must add zeroes to the front to make five. A yacht must receive and record the confirmation code at the conclusion of the withdrawal as evidence of a proper and timely notice. If not able to report while underway, telephone contact must be made immediately after coming ashore. Any boat not so reporting will be scored points equal to a DSQ under YRA SSI 2.0 and is considered a DNE (Disqualification not excludable).

## **12. CREW INFORMATION SHEET**

**12.1.** A Crew Information sheet (**ATTACHMENT 1**) MUST be on file with the YRA office **no later than 1700 hrs the Thursday before the start**. Boats that fail to submit their crew lists by the Thursday deadline will not be considered entered in the race and will be ineligible to race. **13.1.** In accordance with the YRA Standing Sailing Instructions.

## **14. RELEASE OF LIABILITY**

**14.1.** Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizer (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result of participation in this event. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
