Rules, Eligibility and Event Classification

- This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing, 2005-2008, the rules of the participating Classes, the Declaration of Trust and Conditions Governing the Seaweed Soup Perpetual Trophy, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are modified by the Sailing Instructions), and by the Sailing Instructions.
- All sailboats are invited to participate. Each sailboat shall have a current Northern California PHRF certificate or shall be a member of a one-design class.
- This regatta is designated Category A.

Entries, Registration, Competitors' Briefing

- **Deadline to register is Saturday October 28, 2006.**
- Entry fees are: US Sailing member - \$110.00: Non-member - \$125.00. Entries postmarked after October 28, 2006 - \$150.00
- Return entry forms with check made payable to **GGYC, along with copies of your current PHRF certificate and U.S. Sailing membership card to: Leslie Iacopi, 3415 Broderick St. San Francisco, CA 94123.**
- A competitors briefing will not be held.

Sailing Instructions

- The Sailing Instructions will be available by 1700 hours, Thursday, November 2, 2006, on the Golden Gate Yacht Club web site (www.ggyc.com) and at the Club.
- Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board located in the window on the west side of the interior entrance into the club no later than 0900 hours on the day they are to take effect.

Courses and Racing Area

- The Race Committee may select courses to be set on the City Front and Central San Francisco Bay.

Schedule of Races

- First warning each race day will be at 1100 hours.
- Five races are scheduled, of which two (2) must be completed to constitute a series. If five races are scored, each boat has one throw-out. If 4 or fewer races are scored, all races will count in each boat's score.
- Race dates are the following Saturdays: **November 4, 2006, December 2, 2006, January 6, 2007, February 3, 2007, and March 3, 2007.**

Scoring

- The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A, will apply.

- One-design classes with five or more entrants may receive their own start if requested **only if their entries are received by October 28, 2006.**

Prizes

- Series winner will be awarded the Manuel Fagundes Seaweed Soup Perpetual Trophy as defined in the Declaration Of Trust for this Regatta.
- Trophies for first, second and third places will be awarded in each division and in each scored one-design class following the final race for the series.

Berthing

- Guest docks will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis free of charge from 0800 hours prior to each race.

Hospitality

- The Golden Gate Yacht Club will be open from 0830 hours.
- Sailors and guests are invited to the Club. Prior to each race, complimentary coffee and pastries will be provided for all competitors.
- No host drinks and complimentary hors d'oeuvres will be served after each race.
